

Santa Fe Ski Team's Honor Code for Health and Safety

So that the Santa Fe Ski Team can continue its basic duty to provide a safe environment for all its athletes to pursue fun, growth and competition on the slopes, every member of the Santa Fe Ski Team Family – including athletes, coaches, directors and officers and parents – agrees to this Honor Code for Health and Safety as a fundamental obligation to each other and to the Team.

By participating in any activity of the Ski Team, I promise, on my honor, to carry out these following three responsibilities to the best of my abilities at all times – meaning at every moment after leaving my car in parking lot at any activity:

1. My Responsibility for Myself:

- To follow and perform every safe practice put into effect by
 - ✓ any state and city authority
 - ✓ the Team
 - ✓ ski resort.

- To *ALWAYS* perform these 3 safe practices:
 - ✓ To wear a face mask covering nose and mouth
 - ✓ To socially distance – which means only riding a chair lift following the ski area's procedures for riding with any other person than my family or travel group member
 - ✓ Those who guessed the 3rd practice was frequent hand-washing get a star!

2. My Responsibility for Other Members:

- To freely help and observe every other member to comply with these safe practices
- To point out when I see a shortcoming in others

- To report to coaches or other adults when I see shortcomings – and especially refusals to comply.

3. ***My Responsibility to the Team Itself:***

- To take an extra dose of responsibility for younger athletes
- To take an extra dose of responsibility if I'm a coach, parent or officer

And most importantly,

- To double-dare-promise to ***NOT TAKE OFFENSE OR BE UPSET WHEN ANOTHER TEAM MEMBER POINTS OUT TO ME WHEN I HAVE MISSED A SAFE PRACTICE!***
